Welcome to our October newsletter....

◆ HARVEST— A huge thank you for your incredible generosity for our harvest festival. The items were gratefully received by

the local food bank to support families in our community. Mr Carter, St John's Church, provided an inspiring assembly to the children about the meaning of Harvest linked to our



school values of discovery and respect.

- ◆ WELLIES AND COATS —Please ensure your child has a named warm coat for break times and outdoor learning. We prefer our children to use all the space available to them at breaks, including the school field.
