- ◆ WELCOME EVENING—As you will have seen in a letter last week, our welcome year group welcome evenings are on Wednesday 14th September at either 3.30pm or 5.00pm. - ◆ ATTENDANCE LINE—Please ring our attendance line on the first day of absence by 9.30am and state the symptoms of why your child is not attending school. We can then complete the register and note the reason for their absence. If we have not heard from you by then we will contact you. Please make all dentist and non-urgent doctors appointments after school.
- ◆ AD HOC MEDICINE—If your child requires any ad-hoc medicine please ensure you complete the appropriate medical forms available from the school office.
- ◆ CONTACT DETAILS—Please ensure the school office has your up to date contact details as well as a second contact for emergencies. It is important that we are able to get hold of a named contact at all times.
- ◆ AFTER SCHOOL—Please do not let your children (preschoolers, infants or juniors) climb the goalposts, netball posts and fencing before or after school. It isn't safe for them or others. Thank you.
- ◆ PE KITS & EARRINGS—Please make sure that your child has the correct PE kit on their PE days. Long hair should be tied back and earrings removed or covered with tape. Only small stud earrings may be worn in school for health and safety reasons—no hoops or dangly earrings please.

- ◆ CHICHESTER BOOK FESTIVAL—As part of the Chichester Book Festival we are fortunate enough to two authors visit our school in early October. Cath Howe, author of The Insiders, will be talking to Year 6 and Year 5 will have a workshop from Judith Eagle. Judith will present her book The Accidental Stowaway.
