Ofcom—Digital literacy report

The report (Children and Parents: Media Use and Attitudes) gives an insight into target areas in education (3-17 year olds): - Almost a quarter of young people are unable to identify between fake and genuine content on social media and a third believed all or most of what they see on social media.

YouTube is still the most used online platform across 3-17 year olds (88%) followed by WhatsApp (55%) and TikTok (53%).
The most common concern from parents was in relation to their children seeing inappropriate content (75%) or adult/ sexual content (73%).
