Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

As part of our Secret of the Standing Stones learning journey we are visiting Butser Ancient Farm on Friday 15th September. This is a unique opportunity for the children to experience first hand what life was like during the Bronze Age. Trips are a hugely important part of life at Southbourne Juniors in helping to bring the learning to life for the children and get out of the classroom to explore our local area, gaining new experiences and perspectives.
