#### School Equipment:

#### Ways to help your child at home:

#### **Reading:**

Please read with your child and encourage them to read several times a week. The reading miles chart in their homework book needs to be signed each time your child reads aloud to an adult at home or if you observe them reading by themselves for around 15 minutes, or you have a discussion with them about their book.

#### Homework:

Homework will continue to be set every Monday and due the following Monday. We use the time to mark and address any misconceptions that may have arisen along with discussing their answers to the reading element. Please ensure that homework books are in school to be marked.

### Numbots/ TTRS:

Children have their logins to be able to continue playing these at home. It is important that children are playing Numbots to develop and consolidate their number fluency. This will help them in different areas within the maths curriculum. Additionally, children need to be working on their understanding of their times tables. TTRS is a good place to practise these however, there are lots of resources available to help them learn them consistently at a pace that suits them without being timed
