
We hope you all have a lovely half term break and look forward to seeing you back on 20th February.

- ◆ **PARENTS EVENING**—We look forward to welcoming you into the school for our parent consultation evenings on either Wednesday 21st February or Thursday 22nd February. This will give you the opportunity to see some of your child's work. Please return your appointment slip to your child's class teacher for a scheduled time.
- ◆ **WORLD BOOK DAY** – World Book Day is on Thursday 7th March, the theme is reading is fun! We welcome the children to come dressed as a character from a story they would like to share. - ◆ **SCIENCE DAY**— British Science week is from 8th-17th March. As a school we will be focussing on a science day on Monday 11th March. The teachers are busy preparing lots of exciting science activities for the day on the theme of 'Time'. We have set a home challenge for our children to enter into the science fair which will be held during our open afternoon on Thursday 14th March. The science fair, was a great success last year so we look forward to seeing the entries this year! This year the challenge is to design a future farming Innovation or future model of a farm—please see the science letter for full information.
- ◆ **CLASS PHOTOS**—Class photographs are on Tuesday 12th March, these will be our usual long, grouped format for each class. Under GDPR recommendations, we require permission for your child to be included in the class photograph. You should be aware that the photographic proofs are sent home for ordering to all parents/carers within their class, therefore all parents/carers within that class will have sight of the photograph. If you DO NOT give your consent for your child to

be included in the class photograph we require you to inform us in writing by Friday 8th March at the absolute latest.

- ◆ **MMR VACCINATIONS**— Routine vaccinations play a huge part in protecting us all against a range of unpleasant and often serious childhood diseases, including measles, mumps and rubella. Check your child is up to date with their MMR and other childhood vaccinations here: www.westsussex.gov.uk/campaigns/childhood-immunisations/ Older children and adults who haven't had both doses of the MMR vaccine could be at risk of measles. Two doses of the MMR vaccine are needed for lifelong protection and it's never too late to catch up on missed vaccinations. Vaccinations are offered free of charge in the UK, simply call your GP practice to book an appointment.
