<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths this half term we will be continuing our focus on numbers to 1000. The maths questions within homework will complement our learning in class.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Our first learning journey this half term will be writing a leaflet persuading people to visit Tutankhamun's tomb. Our second learning journey will be writing poems based around the theme of winter.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In science this term we will continue to focus on our Animals including Humans unit of work. We will create our own Egyptian musical scores and use bells to perform them.</p>
<p>Art</p> <p>In art, we will be focusing on improving our mastery of art and design techniques using clay to create Egyptian Cartouches.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>In RE we are exploring how Advent and Christmas are celebrated around the world</p>	<p>French</p> <p>In French we are exploring how to start a conversation in French? Asking how are you? Asking age, Basic conversation in French, Introducing someone else, Numbers 13-20, Numbers 20-30</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>One of our PE lessons each week will be dance focusing on following dance routines and using this stimulus to create our own. Our second PE lesson will be learning about yoga.
