

# What is the secret of the standing stones?



<b>English</b>  In English we will focus our learning around a range of texts including: UG by Raymond Briggs and The Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura.  We will be writing narratives in the form of diary entries.		<b>Maths</b>  In maths we will start by recapping the 2 times tables before moving on to learning the 4 and 8 times tables. We will then move on to looking at column subtraction and fractions.
<b>History</b> <b>What is the secret of the standing stones?</b> We will be exploring the life of people living in Bronze Age Britain and the changes that occurred between the Stone and Bronze Age. This will involve discovering the monuments they left behind.	<b>Science</b> <b>What do the different rocks look like and where are they found?</b> Children will develop a range of scientific skills to support their understanding of the formation of rocks, fossils and soils. As well as this, children will be able to compare and group different rocks.	<b>PE</b>  In PE, we will be learning the importance of team building skills by participating in outdoor adventurous activities. We will also learn the basics of how to play golf.
<b>DT</b>  We are going to explore different types of bookmarks before teaching the children how to use textile skills to create their own.	<b>PSHE</b>  Our focus is 'Families' this half term, where we will discuss the different types of families that people have and how families share similarities and differences from each other.	<b>Music</b>  Musical Focus: Performance In music we will be learning how to sing and perform the song 'One Moment, One People'.
<b>French</b>  In French we will be learning how to say the parts of the body and numbers from 20 to 50.	<b>Computing</b>  In computing, we will be focusing on learning how to touch type and will be using these skills to publish our English work onto Google Docs.	<b>RE</b>  In RE we will be looking at the Easter story and why it is important to Christians.
