


Year 5 - The Story of the Trojan Horse: Historical Fact, Legend or Myth?

<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>We will begin by continuing our last learning journey of area and scaling. Children will learn to calculate the area of rectangles and composite rectilinear shapes.</p> <p>Times tables continue to be so important for this learning journey so please encourage your child to practise them regularly at home.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Across this half term, we will be creating and writing our own Greek myth to go alongside such stories as Theseus and the Minotaur or Perseus and Medusa. Then, the children will create their own enquiry questions to research and present in their own way, using a range of organisational devices such as a report.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>We will be looking at our Solar System, and exploring how our planet moves within our Solar System. In addition, we will also explore how night and day and the seasons are created due to the Earth's movement.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>Children will be looking at what happened during Holy Week, the Last Supper and the last hours of Jesus's life?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>We will be continuing to look at Ancient Greece at the time of the Trojan War. Children will look at the wider Ancient Greek world, looking at the legacies of the Greeks: engineering, democracy and the Olympics.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>In our PE sessions, we will be focusing on developing social, teamwork and communication skills through our Physical Cog in Real PE. Children will also be working collaboratively as we start our Basketball learning.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p>How can we help in an accident or an emergency? The children will learn about the safe way to respond in an emergency by learning basic first aid, how to stay safe around water and how to deal with a variety of emergencies.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>The children will use greenscreens to create a piece of immersive Greek theatre, using their masks from last half term and their knowledge of ancient myths and stories to inspire them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>Our musical focus will be dynamics and structure - we will continue to look at how Holst represents planets through his music, and composition.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">DT</p> <p>We will be designing an electronic bookmark with a simple electrical control circuit.</p> 		<p style="text-align: center;">French</p> <p>Children will become confident at describing the weather. They will also discuss how many countries around the world are French speaking. Using the French book, La météo d'elmer, the children will have a go writing / translating a similar story.</p>
