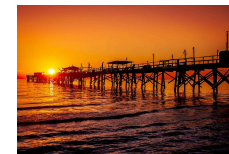


Beyond the Magic Kingdom: What is the Sunshine State really like?



<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In maths, we will be learning how to subtract using the column method then starting our fractions unit by looking at unit fractions and non-unit fractions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>In English this half term, our focus will be on writing to inform.</p> <p>We will also spend time writing reflections on the year so far ready for our end of year reports.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>In science, our focus for the half term is around light. By the end of the unit of work children should know:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● that they need light in order to see things ● that dark is the absence of light ● that light can be reflected from surfaces ● that light from the sun can be dangerous ● how to protect their eyes from the sun ● that shadows are formed when a light source is blocked by a solid object
<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>What is the Sunshine State really like?</p> <p>We will be gaining an understanding of the physical and human geographical features of Florida in North America.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>In computing we will be learning how to programme microbits so that they take on the form of digital dice.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">DT</p> <p>Our DT learning will be connected to both our Geography as we develop our knowledge of structures in order for us to design and make a structure that will protect turtle nests from predators and humans.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE, the focus for the half term will be around keeping ourselves safe. This will involve learning basic first aid, how to make a call to the emergency services and how to lower the risks of dangerous scenarios.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>In music, we will be focusing on songs we have learnt over the past year in lessons and in singing assemblies. We will be working to identify different elements that make up songs like verses and choruses.</p>
