Year 6 Trip – Junior Citizen Child Safety Event, Monday 20th April 2026

We are pleased to inform you that our Year 6 pupils will be attending the Arun & Chichester Junior Citizen Child Safety Event held at Goodwood for year 6 pupils across the county. Junior Citizen is a multi-agency event designed specifically for children aged 10–11. It focuses on developing important life skills that help children keep themselves and others safe. At this age, pupils are becoming more independent and preparing for changes such as the transition to secondary school, so the event aims to raise their awareness of potential risks and dangers in a fun, practical and interactive way.

The event will be delivered by representatives from the emergency services and local agencies, who will guide pupils through a range of realistic safety scenarios.

Pupils will travel by coach, leaving school at 12 noon and will return immediately after the event, departing the venue at approximately 2:45pm. **If your child usually has hot meals please arrange for a packed lunch as they will need to eat slightly earlier than usual. FSM packed lunches will need to be booked on Parent Pay by 27th March 2026 if required.**

This is a valuable opportunity for pupils to build confidence, learn essential safety skills and prepare for increased independence as they move towards secondary school. We are subsidising this visit, but require a £5 voluntary contribution in order for it to go ahead. Please return the permission slip and contribution by Friday 27th March: without sufficient contributions we will need to cancel the trip.
