We are delighted to tell you about an exciting fundraising challenge that our school will be taking part in to support children who are less fortunate than ourselves.

We have been inspired by Charlie and Daisy, who are friends of our Junior Duke Ambassador, Jess Rowe. You may remember that Jess rowed across the Pacific Ocean last year! Charlie and Daisy are currently cycling around the world in just 365 days to raise money for a charity called Future Hope, which supports vulnerable children in India.

Future Hope helps children living on the streets by providing care, support and education. The charity offers a safe home for children without families and provides educational opportunities for children from some of the poorest communities. To support Charlie and Daisy's incredible challenge, members of our Wellbeing Club will be undertaking their own adventure after school on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June. Their goal is to complete 365 laps of the school field, mirroring the 365 days that Charlie and Daisy are spending cycling around the world. The children will complete the challenge using a variety of wheeled equipment, including scooters, skateboards and similar items.

To help support this challenge, **all pupils will have the opportunity to take part during lunchtime on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June should they wish.** For a donation of **50p per lap**, children can complete a lap of the track using a selection of wheeled items provided by the school, including scooters, a wheelbarrow and even a pram! Every lap completed will contribute to our overall total and help raise money for Future Hope.

As a school, we are hoping to raise £365, matching the 365 days of Charlie and Daisy's remarkable journey around the world. Members of the Wellbeing Club have already been collecting sponsorship money, and we hope that as many pupils as possible will choose to take part in the lunchtime event. Every additional 50p contribution will help us move closer to our target and make a meaningful difference to the lives of children supported by Future Hope.

One of the Five Ways to Wellbeing is Give. This encourages us to show kindness, generosity and compassion by helping others and contributing positively to our community. We believe this fundraising challenge is a wonderful opportunity for our children to put this value into practice while supporting other young people to access the care and education they deserve.
