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| <p><b>Maths</b><br/><b>Add and subtract across 10</b><br/><b>Numbers to 1000</b></p> <p>We will start Maths by recapping the skills to add and subtract across 10. We will then spend the rest of the half term looking at numbers to 1000.</p>                                                                                                                                                                                            | <p><b>English</b></p> <p>We will start the year by focusing on the book 'Marcy and the riddle of the sphinx' by Joe Todd - Stanton. We will be taking inspiration from the illustrations to create a setting and character description. There are lots of other amazing books by the author so if your child is interested in these texts please encourage them to find these books in a local library.</p> | <p><b>Science</b><br/><b>Animals including humans</b></p> <p>In science this term we will focus on our Animals including Humans unit of work. This will involve learning about nutrition, muscles and skeletons. We will use our learning about nutrition to design and make our own pizzas so please ensure any dietary or medical concerns have been shared with their class teacher.</p> |
| <p><b>PSHE</b><br/><b>Me, my friends and belonging</b></p> <p>In PSHE, we will be exploring the themes of friendship and respect. We will also learn about healthy friendships and ways to make others feel included.</p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                  | <p><b>Computing</b><br/><b>Touch typing</b></p> <p>In computing, we will be focusing on learning how to touch type. We will then use these skills to publish our English writing.</p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                       | <p><b>Music</b><br/><b>Can I create a rhythmic soundscape?</b></p> <p>We will be exploring rhythm through Egyptian terms to create rhythmic soundscapes of Egyptian life. These lessons will be taught by Mr Iyengar, a local music teacher and specialist in Kodály; a world-renowned approach to music education developed by Hungarian composer Zoltán Kodály.</p>                       |
| <p><b>DT</b><br/><b>Seasonal food</b></p> <p>We will explore where food comes from and our local seasonal food. The children will design and create a healthy and nutritious recipe for a seasonal tart.</p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                               | <p><b>RE</b><br/><b>Faith communities</b></p> <p>We will be exploring what faith communities are and how Christians, Jews and Christians show how they belong.</p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                          | <p><b>French</b><br/><b>Introduction to French</b></p> <p>In French we will be learning French greetings, classroom instructions, saying your name, numbers 1-12.</p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                       |
| <p><b>PE</b><br/><b>Rugby and Dodgeball</b></p> <p>One of our PE lessons each week will be learning about tag rugby. This will support the children in developing their understanding of attacking and defending principles of invasion games and passing and receiving a ball with control. Our second PE lesson will be learning about Dodgeball.
