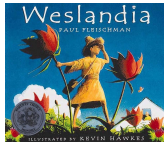
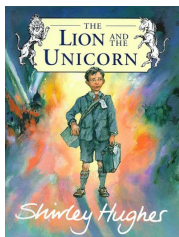


On Our Doorstep: How has Southbourne changed?
